Cy-Hope offers financial assistance to underserved students in Cy-Fair ISD to take Advanced Placement or Dual Credit courses.

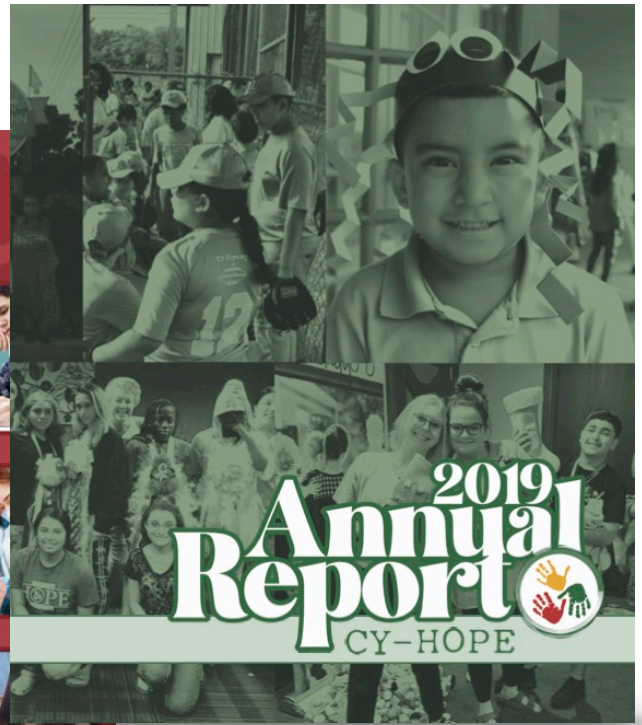
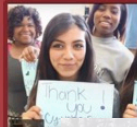
Students earn college credit at much less expense than if taking these courses at a community or four-year college. This program recognizes that not all students are college bound and also covers fees for vocational certifications.

Hours are 9:15am - 2:15pm.

Foundry Preschool follows the Cy-Fair ISD calendar with a few exceptions.

A snack is provided daily for all children.

A healthy lunch should be brought from home.

Foundry has age appropriate outdoor play areas as well as indoor play space for bad weather days.

Chapel, music and library are offered weekly.

Each room is equipped with its own bathroom, sink and diaper changing station (MDO classes).

Registration

Children are registered annually on a first come first serve basis. A completed registration & medical form is needed along with the annual registration fee at the time of registration. Students may transfer from one school to another as long as there is space available. Registration for the following school year usually occurs the first part of February. Please call the school for more information or to schedule a tour.
